Position summary:

The Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP); Physician (MD/DO) is an independent provider who works collaboratively within a multi-disciplinary health care team to provide quality care to patients. The FNP/MD demonstrates the patient centered standard of practice by making patients and their families the primary focus of care. The FNP/MD will provide services in clinic sites, homes, fields, schools and orchards as requested. The ideal candidate will be sensitive to problems of migrant and seasonal farmworkers and their families and must be willing and able to travel in the area and out of state as needed. Will consider hiring two part-time providers in any combination of FNP or MD in place of one full-time.

Duties:

- The FNP/MD Performs comprehensive health assessments and physical examinations of patients throughout the lifespan
- Provides preventative health measures and chronic disease management
- Initiates and interprets diagnostic tests

- Documents clinical findings and formulates plan and prognosis based on patient's condition
- Gives definitive treatment and initiates referrals to contractual providers in accordance with MMC's designated priorities
- Consults with other health care professionals to insure quality, evidence-based care
- Performs follow-up care when indicated
- Coordinates care between specialty providers as needed
- Whenever the need arises, is willing to do intake and provide or locate supportive services for patients in need
- Sets high standards of performance for self and others and assumes responsibility and accountability for successfully completing assignments or tasks
- The FNP/MD provides consultation to other staff members as needed
- Participates in CQI activities as requested
- Assists in the development and review of protocols, policies, clinical guidelines, procedures and patient handouts
- Participates in peer review
- Attends and participates in staff and departmental meetings
- Disseminates patient-care related information to team members as needed
- The FNP/MD updates skills and knowledge base continually to meet current evidence-based standards of patient care

Position Requirements:

1. Licensure/Certification/Registration: Current Wyoming Advanced Practice Registered Nurse, Physician or Physician's Assistant License with prescriptive authority and DEA licensure

2. Current BLS certification

3. Graduate of an accredited Program

4. Credentialing by national certifying body

5. Prefer 2-3 years' experience as provider in primary and/or acute care; will consider new graduates

6. Bilingual in English/Spanish preferred, but not required (interpreters available on site)
